Chiang Mai is about 700 km from Bangkok. Take Highway No. 1 (Phahonyothin Road) and turn to Highway No. 32 (Asia Highway) passing Ayutthaya, Angthong, Nakhon Sawan, then by Highway No. 117 to Phitsanulok and by Highway No. 11, from Lampang, Lamphun to Chiang Mai.

BY BUS

Buses leave Bangkok for Chiang Mai from the Mor Chit (often spelt Moh Chit or Mo Chit) Bus Station in the Chatuchak Market area. Buses usually run from 6.00am till 10.00pm. Most trips take around 11hrs. For more information.
